- > Employment. Averages, Responsible Persons, Full Time Equivalent, Volunteers
- ➤ Operating Surplus (\$ and %). Averages, Surplus per Employee, Surplus by Profitability Status
- > Operating Surplus Deep Dive. Profitability vs Size, Drivers of Surplus, For-Profit Comparisons.

Workshop Takeouts Participants will receive benchmarking tables (percentiles 25th, median, 75th) by Sector Type for (a) Revenue, Revenue per Employee, Revenue Composition, (b) Expenses, Expenses per Employee, Employee Expenses by Direct and Estimated Overheads, (c) Operating Surplus \$ and %, and (d) Financial Vulnerability – Liquidity and Revenue Concentration.

3.0 Organisational DNA Strategic and Financial Vulnerability

Themes

- Organisational DNA and Capacity to Transform. How to meet the challenges of self-sufficiency, rising demand, donations collapse, restricted funding, and managing for purpose and outcomes.
